'Bottom up to Kyoto' becomes partner of the 'Sustainable Energy Europe Campaign 2005-2008'.

Bottom up to Kyoto (ButK), the initiative launched by the European Lamp Companies Federation in partnership with Berliner Energieagentur, AIE, EUEW and 5 municipalities in Europe with the aim of replacing the current office and street lighting systems with energy efficient ones, has become partner of the 'Sustainable Energy Europe Campaign 2005-2008'.

The **Sustainable Energy Europe 2005-2008 Campaign** (SEE) is a European Commission initiative in the framework of the Intelligent Energy-Europe (2003-2006) programme, which aims to raise public awareness and promote sustainable energy production and use among individuals and organisations, private companies and public authorities, professional and energy agencies, industry associations and NGOs across Europe.

The partnership with 'Sustainable Energy Europe Campaign 2005-2006' is one of the first dissemination activities of ButK, by means of which it intends to gain visibility and join the countless initiatives which are being launched in the field of energy efficiency, at European level.

ButK is a pilot project supported by the EACI (Executive Agency for Competitiveness and Innovation, former IEEA) that will run from 2007 to 2009.
